Executive summary

- 198 patients distributed prosthetic bra – patients saved Rs 23.76 lacs

We are pleased to inform you that Win Over Cancer undertook following activities during the quarter April- June 2018:

A. Medical Support Services

1. Free distribution of Prosthetic Bra:

- a. Your NGO has distributed prosthetic bras to more than 198 patients this month across 19 States. On a year to year basis, this represents a **230% growth** in the number of beneficiaries as compared to same period in last year
- b. Patients have saved an amount of Rs 23.76 lac from this program alone during this period

2. **Crowd Funding Activities:** Win Over Cancer had been taking responsibility for treatment of several needy children and adults. Pleased to inform you that treatment of 3 patients was successfully completed this quarter. 5 new patients were inducted in the program in this quarter. A summary of the programs is as below:



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a. Treatment successfully completed

- i. 8 year old Baby Sarika
- ii. 16 Year old Akanksha
- iii. 23 year Rajni

b. Treatment in progress

- i. 21 year old Prince : This State level football player would need rigorous treatment for five more months to survive his ALL
- ii. 14 year old Pawan: This brave boy from Haryana will be undergoing treatment for another four months
- iii. 12 year old Nitin: 1 months of treatment is left. The boy is attending school as a normal child.
- iv. 12 year Sakeer: Brave son of a poor fruit vendor, he will be fighting it out for another five months

c. New patients added this quarter

- i. 17 year old Akash: Son of a daily wage laborer from Hissar fighting ALL
- ii. 46 year old Mangat Singh: A very poor farmer from Chindwara, Madhya Pradesh fighting mouth cancer
- iii. 35 year old Akash Tyagi: CML patient from rural Ghaziabad. Lost his job to cancer. Struggling to fight cancer and meet ends meet
- iv. 45 year old Anand: NHL patient from Ghaziabad, father of two young daughters, struggling with his paltry job
- v. 57 year old Ramzaan: CML patient from Ballabhgarh, fighting CLL with his family of six



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3. Awareness drives:

- a. **Awareness drive at Pahera Kalan, Faridabad:** Win Over Cancer, National Organization for Social Welfare Trust and Sarodaya Hospital organized a cancer awareness and detection drive at village Pahera Kalan, Faridabad. 268 villagers benefitted from the camp

B. Financial Rehabilitation services

1. Skill development programs:

- a. **Nishtha Singh**, 18 year old daughter of a very poor farmer Mangat Singh was enrolled with Tally Education program at Chhindwara, Madhya Pradesh. Nishtha passed her class XII exams this year in first division while taking care of her father. Due to family's financial conditions, she was looking to be a bread earner. This program will provide her a platform for a long term career progression. Win Over Cancer is also providing her scholarship for meeting her commuting expenses from her village to Chhindwara and back.
- b. **Sakwan Gaitely** successfully completed her training and was placed with a mid-sized firm in administrative and accounts capacity. After the demise of her husband due to cancer last year, Sakwan had been struggling with her finances. The program has helped her achieve long term financial independence and take care of her nine year old son as well.
- b. **Master Vivek:** Win Over Cancer has been supporting education of this brave cancer fighter boy. Pleased to inform that this son of a poor farmer from Aligarh has successfully passed his class Xth board examinations this year
- c. **Master Nitin:** Win Over Cancer is committed to support real fighters. Master Nitin is one such boy. Nitin hails from a very poor family. The boy is attending school while undergoing



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chemotherapy. Win Over Cancer is supporting this fighter boy. In addition to paying for his treatment, we have decided to pay for school fee.

- d. New Skill Development centers:** Win Over Cancer is pleased to announce association with 10,000+ more centers during this quarter. Total center count now stands at 16,802

C. Others

1. **Win Over Cancer goes global:** Win Over Cancer represented India at a global summit on “Care for Cancer” organized by Uppsala University in Sweden. The summit was attended by over 180 delegates from 32 countries. Representatives from several countries expressed willingness and need to replicate the financial rehabilitation services model of Win Over Cancer in their country

Akriti has connected more than 2,500 Delhi University students on the cause through over 22 camps during last three years.
